Stay happy, stay shining, and make every day of your summer vacation a special one!

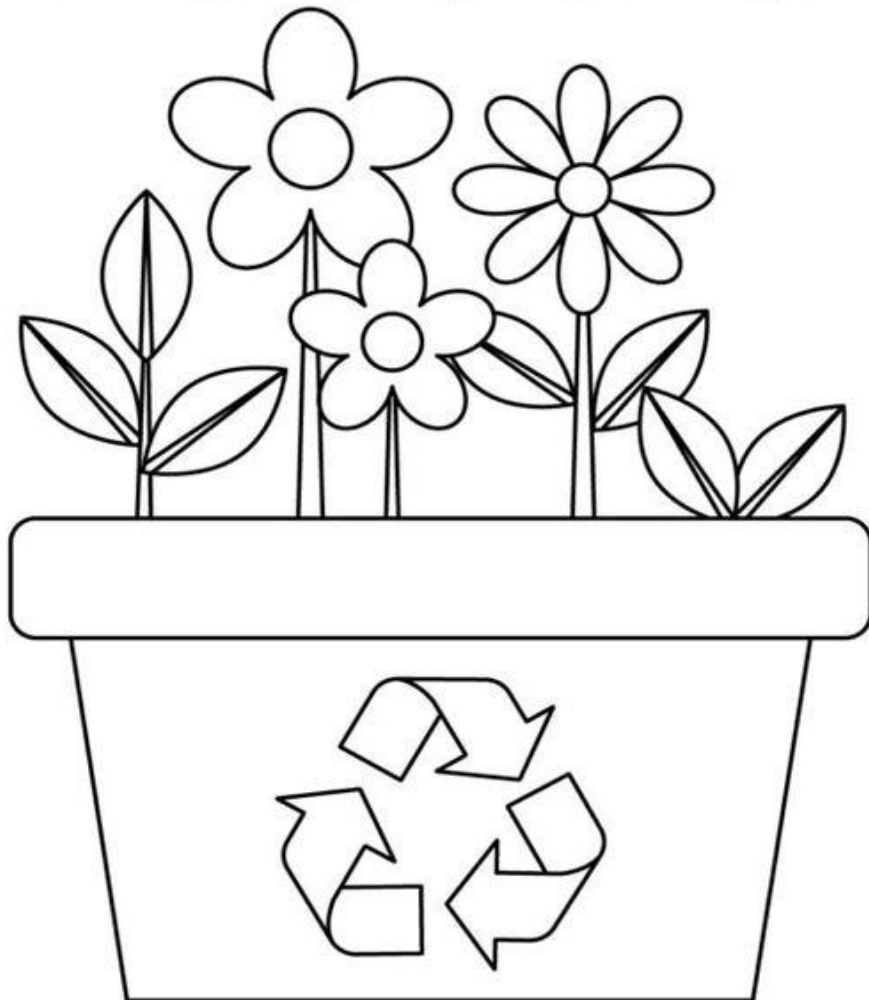
