- Chapter 3 – Subtraction

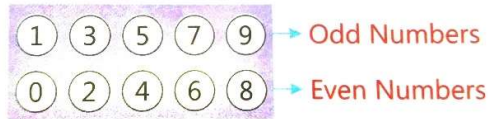
