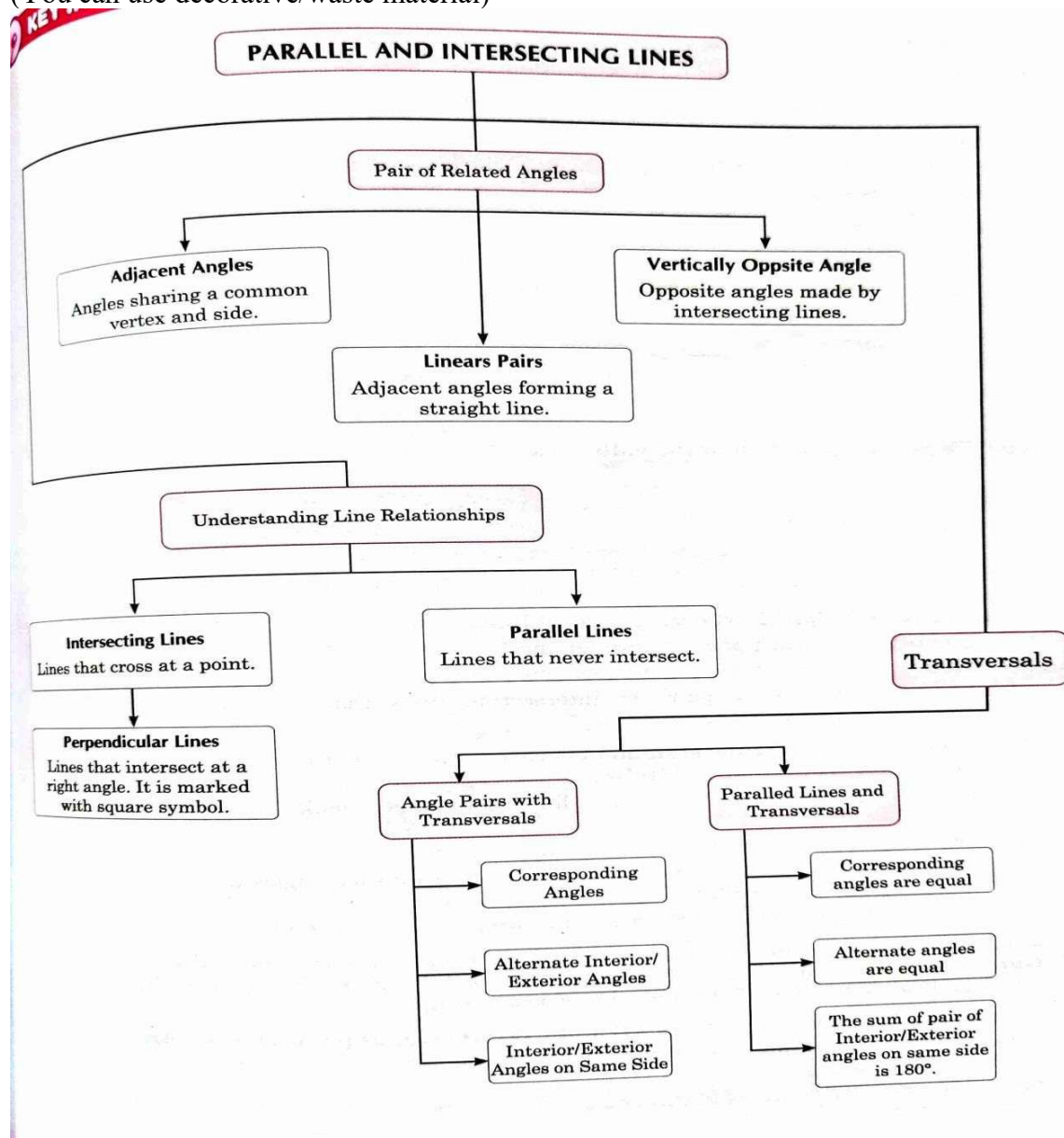

Q5. ACTIVITY!

To verify that when a transversal intersects parallel lines, the pairs of corresponding angles are equal. (given)

(Do below activity on A4 sheets use colourful pens.)

LAB ACTIVITY

Objective: To verify that when a transversal intersects parallel lines, the pairs of corresponding angles are equal.

Materials Required: A4 sheets, a pair of scissors, sketch pens, a compass, a pencil, and a ruler.

Procedure:

Step 1: Divide the children into groups. Give each group the required materials.

Step 2: On a sheet of paper, draw two parallel lines, AB and CD, and a transversal line EF that intersects them. Following the diagram in your textbook (or the one shown here for reference), label the angles formed as 1, 2, 3, 4 at the top intersection and 8, 5, 6, 7 at the bottom intersection.

Step 3: The goal is to compare the angles in the following pairs:

$\angle 1$ and $\angle 8$	$\angle 3$ and $\angle 6$
$\angle 2$ and $\angle 5$	$\angle 4$ and $\angle 7$

These pairs are known as corresponding angles because they are in the same position at each intersection.

Step 4: Using scissors, carefully cut out the section of paper containing angle $\angle 1$.

Step 5: Place the cut-out of angle $\angle 1$ directly on top of angle $\angle 8$.

Observation 1: You will observe that angle $\angle 1$ fits perfectly over angle $\angle 8$.


This demonstrates that $\angle 1 = \angle 8$.

Step 6: Now, repeat the process for another pair. Cut out angle $\angle 2$ and place it on top of angle $\angle 5$.

Observation 2: You will find that angle $\angle 2$ is a perfect match for angle $\angle 5$, showing that $\angle 2 = \angle 5$. You can continue this process for the remaining pairs ($\angle 3$ with $\angle 6$, and $\angle 4$ with $\angle 7$) to see the same result.

Conclusion:

This activity shows that when a transversal cuts across two parallel lines, the angles in corresponding positions are equal. We have verified that $\angle 1 = \angle 8$, $\angle 2 = \angle 5$, $\angle 3 = \angle 6$, and $\angle 4 = \angle 7$.
